## Twinkle Twinkle Little Star 2



Now that you've played through some of these exercises, let's tackle our first arrangement: "Twinkle Twinkle Little Star." In this and the next example, I have included block chord diagrams to help you find the proper fingering. Remember to play as many notes out of the chord position as you can.

To get started, place your thumb on the 4th string and use one finger per string. For more expressiveness, pluck the chords in a quick rolling motion, starting with your thumb.

The two-note "double stops" on the downbeat of measures 2 & 10 are played as pinches with your thumb and ring finger. Sometimes it is easier to play only part of a chord.

Practice playing the entire piece slowly – try to find a tempo that allows you to play it all the way through without errors.
