 [D7] Side [G7] by [C] side.

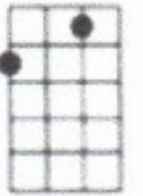
[E7] Other pals may shake me

 [D7] Side [G7] by [C] side.

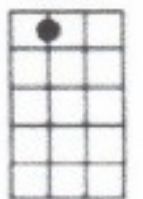
