Strum Patterns:

Basic: A single down strum on each chord. Be aware, when a chord is repeated several times, ukulele music doesn't usually have the repeat chords written. Therefore strum on the first beat of the bar,

Intermediate: $\downarrow / \downarrow \uparrow / \uparrow \downarrow \uparrow$ $/ \uparrow / \uparrow / \uparrow \downarrow \uparrow$

This pattern comprises two bars of strumming, where a '/' is a silence. During a silence, the hand should still move in it's natural direction, but without striking the strings.
e.g:

1/11/11

The hand would still move \(\gamma\) in readiness for the forthcoming down strum, but without hitting the strings.

Advanced: All chord shapes should be formed at the same intervals as if you were strumming, however the pattern of fingerpicking is thus:



Thumb plucks downwards, index and middle fingers pluck upwards. Pink finger should remain rested on the ukulele at all times in order to keep the hand's position stable.

With this pattern, the thumb plucks should last for twice as long as the other two notes, giving a lilting effect the music.
